

## **CFA Scholarships for Levels 1, 2, and 3 Exam in 2022**

### **Details**

The scholarship waives the one-time enrollment fee (\$450) and discounts the exam costs (\$650 - \$1380) to \$350.

### **Eligibility**

1. As a CFA Program Partner university, we (Prof. Narayanan Jayaraman and Prof. Manpreet Hora) can award up to a total of **12** student scholarships for **2022**.
2. The scholarships are open to all Georgia Tech students. However, the preference would be given to Scheller College of Business graduate and undergraduate students.

### **Submission Process**

1. If you meet the CFA the eligibility requirements above, you can submit the application for student scholarship online through the CFA account page. The link is: [https://cfai.smapply.io/prog/cfa\\_program\\_student\\_scholarship/](https://cfai.smapply.io/prog/cfa_program_student_scholarship/)
2. In the attachment section of the application, please attach the following:
  - a. CV/Resume
  - b. Current Academic Transcript – Unofficial one from GT will suffice
3. Please ensure you put your valid GT (ending with gatech.edu) email address.
4. Please ensure to go through the document “Student Guide to Student Scholarships” (link: <https://info.cfainstitute.org/rs/357-TRH-938/images/Student%20Guide%20to%20Student%20Scholarships.pdf>) that has been prepared by the CFA Institute. This document details (1) the Scholarship Award Information, and (2) how to apply for the CFA Program Student Scholarship
5. We will review the scholarship application submitted online and you will be communicated of the decision by the CFA Institute.

### **Important Dates for May 2022 Exam**

Application deadline January 10, 2022. Award decision will be made by us by January 14, 2022

Please remember that the CFA Institute takes additional two weeks to communicate their final decision.

### **Important Dates for August 2022 Exam**

Application deadline March 30, 2022. Award decision will be made by us by April 7, 2022

Earlier applications, that is applications before the deadline are encouraged.
