This is a fantastic opportunity for a Georgia Tech student to apply their skills in education, communication, or human services to enhance our Girls Link Up after-school curriculum. Student candidate(s) will present an end of the semester project based on the following guidelines.

As a Social Impact Fellow, you will:

- Enhance Curriculum: Contribute to the development of innovative and engaging curriculum ideas to supplement the Girls Link Up program, ensuring that it remains relevant and exciting for young learners.
- **Organize Resources:** Create and maintain a comprehensive online directory of lessons, activities, and program tools, making it easy for educators to access and implement.
- **Develop Training Materials:** Work collaboratively to produce high-quality training materials, including a user-friendly guide or book, to equip program facilitators with the knowledge and skills needed to deliver effective STEAM education.
- **Design Engaging Materials:** Utilize design tools (e.g., Canva, Adobe InDesign) to create visually appealing and informative training materials that capture the attention of educators and inspire them to implement the curriculum.

Qualifications:

- Strong interest in women and girls' equity, particularly in STEM fields.
- Excellent organizational and time management skills.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Proficiency in design tools (e.g., Canva, Adobe InDesign) is a plus.
- Experience in education, communication, or human services is preferred.

This internship is a collaboration with the Institute for Leadership and Social Impact (ILSI) at Georgia Tech. The student selected for this position will receive a Social Impact Fellowship from ILSI in the amount of \$1,800 upon verification of their eligibility for a scholarship with the Financial Aid of ILSI. Students are expected to work 10 hours a week on average. Students need to be enrolled full-time. ILSI will handle onboarding and the payment process, and Fellows are expected to complete a blog post about their internship experience and participate in one Fellowship event with ILSI.
