Position Overview

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct grant and funding research to support youth entrepreneurship, art, and agriculture initiatives.
- Assist with partnership outreach to community markets, farms, and youth-serving organizations.
- Contribute to the development of youth-facing materials (workbooks, worksheets, and activity guides).
- Track and share impact stories through newsletters, digital platforms, and internal reports.
- Attend SouthSea Rising and Nourish Botanica events to capture content (photos, video, reels).
- Create engaging social media posts that highlight youth programs, partnerships, and community impact.

Ideal Candidate

- Strong research, writing, and organizational skills.
- Interest in youth entrepreneurship, social impact, or creative economies.
- Passion for social media, content creation, and current trends.
- Familiarity with Canva, Instagram/TikTok, or other editing tools.
- Comfortable working independently and remotely, with occasional event attendance.
