HouseATL seeks a Georgia Tech intern for the summer semester of 2026 to support its growing, mission-focused membership coalition. HouseATL is a cross-sector membership coalition of civic leaders committed to building the public will for a comprehensive and coordinated housing affordability action plan for Atlanta. The organization is fiscally sponsored by the Community Foundation for Greater Atlanta, and its offices are co-located with the Community Foundation. HouseATL has its own Advisory Board, elected by the membership, and it is currently staffed by an Executive Director, a Membership Associate and Policy and Project Associate. The person in this internship role will support the [DeKalb Housing Roundtable](#) and city/county policy work including research, survey analysis, educational video development, creating documents like one pagers, etc. The person would also assist with improvements to our membership database and communications and with event planning. This is a hybrid work situation, with some remote work but also with some in-person meetings and activities. Responsibilities:

- Research and organize information as needed
- Support events such as in-person meetings, preparing materials and presentations, taking notes, assisting with speaker invitations, etc.
- Support communications efforts by creating facebook posts, newsletters, and emails
- Assist with coordinating, conducting, and organizing interviews and recordings for various advocacy-focused video projects.
- Support summer video production efforts, including preparation, logistics, and content management.
- Analyze data collected through Resident Activation initiatives and help synthesize key insights into usable summaries and reports.
- Assist in the management of member data via the ClubExpress Platform.
- Support member engagement activities to include tabling events and meetings.

Qualifications:

- Must be a current Georgia Tech student
- Mission aligned with a strong sense of purpose
- Excellent verbal and written communications and interpersonal skills
- Ability to interact professionally and effectively with a diversity of external stakeholders
- Reliable and trustworthy – follows through on responsibilities in a timely and ethical manner
- Able to conduct independent research

This internship is a collaboration with the Institute for Leadership and Social Impact (ILSI) at Georgia Tech. The student selected for this position will receive a Social Impact Fellowship from

ILSI in the amount of \$1,800 upon verification of their eligibility for a scholarship with the Financial Aid office. Students are expected to work 10 hours a week on average. Students need to be enrolled full-time. ILSI will handle onboarding and the payment process, and Fellows are expected to complete a blog post about their internship experience and participate in one Fellowship event with ILSI.
