Our Summer Academy provides scholars with rigorous academic instruction, hands-on STEM learning, and transformative experiences that build confidence and mathematical identity.

Position Overview

The Social Impact Fellow will play a critical operational and storytelling role in Math N' More Summer Academy. This fellow will ensure enrollment and operational systems are accurate and compliant while also capturing and sharing the real-time impact of our programming through compelling social media storytelling. This is an ideal role for a detail-oriented, mission-driven Georgia Tech student interested in education equity, nonprofit operations, and digital storytelling.

Key Responsibilities

Operations and Enrollment Support:

- Verify enrollment documents and ensure completeness and accuracy
- Manage scholar records, schedules, class assignments, and permission forms using Playground
- Track and organize field trip permission documentation
- Support administrative workflows that ensure smooth daily academy operation

Social Impact Storytelling and Communications:

- Capture and curate photos and videos submitted by staff and instructors
- Develop engaging social media content using Canva
- Publish content across platforms using Publer

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- Maintain real-time social media updates highlighting scholar learning, field trips, and academy culture
- Help build Math N' More's digital presence and public narrative of impact

- Current Georgia Tech undergraduate or graduate student
- Strong attention to detail and organizational skills
- Interest in education, nonprofit leadership, or social impact
- Experience with Canva, social media platforms, or digital content creation preferred
- Ability to manage confidential student information responsibly

- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines

This position is a collaboration with the Institute for Leadership and Social Impact (ILSI) at Georgia Tech. The student selected for this position will receive a Social Impact Fellowship from ILSI in the amount of \$1,800 upon verification of their eligibility for a scholarship with the Financial Aid office. Students are expected to work 10 hours a week for 10 weeks. Students need to be enrolled full-time. ILSI will handle onboarding and the payment process, and Fellows are expected to complete deliverables about their experience.
