Position Overview: The Social Enterprise Intern position is a partnership between Global Growers Network and Georgia Tech. The position will support the Social Enterprise Expansion Project that is being undertaken by Global Growers. The position is expected to be offered Fall 2020 and Spring 2021

About Global Growers Network: Global Growers Network partners with people from diverse cultures who grow fresh food for their families and for local marketplaces. Together, we build and sustain networks of people, land, resources, and markets in order to create a more equitable food system that is driven by cultural diversity, inclusive economies, and regenerative agriculture practices. Over 300 families, most of whom are resettled refugees, grow fresh, culturally familiar food across our network of eight farm and garden sites on 22 acres of land in metro Atlanta.

About The Social Enterprise Expansion Project: The Social Enterprise Expansion Project: This project will recommend strategies for the farmers that Global Growers serves to increase their ownership and control over market operations, as well as the success of those operations, in distributing the sustainably grown produce and farm foods that they produce. Specific elements of the project include:

- Gathering farmer input for feedback and direction
- Analyzing market and current buyer capacity
- Develop and operational assessment and financial analysis
- Evaluate governance structures and IT systems.
- Evaluate market readiness services and programs.

Internship Responsibilities: Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we expect that most responsibilities for this position will be conducted remotely. Because of the remote nature of this position, the candidate will need to have regular phone, computer and internet access. Fall projects are likely to include: developing case studies of agricultural marketing cooperatives and social enterprise businesses; supporting farmer focus groups and stakeholder interviews; researching and compiling supporting information; drafting market and feasibility background materials.

Qualifications and Experience Requirements: Strong writing and research background, with knowledge/experience supporting focus groups and conducting case studies. Sustainable agriculture and multicultural work or lived experiences a plus.



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Location: Global Growers Network's office is located in Decatur, GA in a nonprofit co-working space operated by the City of Decatur at Legacy Park, a beautiful 77-acre greenspace that is also home to our Decatur's Kitchen Garden and Orchard. Our current farm and garden sites are located in Decatur, Clarkston, and Stone Mountain. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we expect that most responsibilities for this position will be conducted remotely.

Schedule and Terms: The position will require 12-15 hours per week from September 15, 2020 to December 11, 2020. A stipend of \$1500 will be provided in form of a Social Impact Fellowship with the Institute for Leadership and Social Impact.
